Dear Presidents of National Federations,

Suite à la préoccupation croissante liée au virus COVID-19,

The Board of Directors of African Kickboxing Confederation (WAKO AFRICA) has decided to postpone all Kickboxing related activities until further notice.

The following factors have been taken into consideration. Even if the situation was judged to be under control in Cameroon and according to WHO recommendations,

- the crisis has not stabilized in Africa;
- it is very difficult to prevent its development in the coming days.
- and traveling across the continent becomes more and more complicated if not impossible for certain countries due to the restrictions put in place.

For all these reasons and to avoid any unnecessary risk, the Cameroonian State has decided to postpone all sporting and cultural activities to take place in its territory and to close its borders until further notice.

Consequently the Board of Directors also decided that it was necessary to postpone the General Assembly, the Meeting of the Executive Board and the 2020 African Championships scheduled for April in Yaoundé - Cameroon.

We want to assure you that African Kickboxing Confederation is monitoring the situation closely. The African Kickboxing Confederation Board of Directors will propose a new date as desired based on the improvement of the situation.

However, the date from August 24 to 30 has been provisionally retained by the Ministry of Sports and Physical Education.

In the meantime, Please accept, Dear Brother Presidents, the expression of our solidarity.
